COURSE DESCRIPTION

The *USC Diabetes Symposium* returns for its 4th year, continuing to provide exciting updates in the care of people with diabetes, as well as the accompanying complications and comorbidities.

This hybrid program, offered in person and over virtual platform, presents updates in the field of diabetes and obesity management from experts in a variety of fields.

Highlighted are areas of advancement including updates to guideline-based medical therapy, management of peripheral neuropathy, strategies for reducing of cardiovascular risk, managing diabetes in the inpatient setting and in the geriatric population, updates in diabetes technology and discussion of cutting-edge therapies such as new bariatric procedures and weekly insulin.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- · Identify patients who are candidates for cardio and renal protective medications.
- Know the benefits of once-weekly insulin therapy.
- · Treat obesity in the context of diabetes.
- Integrate strategies for reduction of polypharmacy, especially in older adults.

This course is intended for endocrinologists, primary care providers, nurses, trainees and other health professionals that care for those with diabetes and obesity to enhance their knowledge of up to date treatment strategies.
