COURSE DESCRIPTION

This program will focus on providing the attendee an update on the latest aspects of ophthalmic best practices across the field, research updates for recently approved therapies for ophthalmic disease, and research updates regarding pipeline therapies that may soon be available.

- Examine the efforts used to mitigate the severity of, or to regenerate the function lost due to degenerative ocular disease.
