COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course offers a review of important and timely topics in the field of obstetrics and gynecology. Based on a review of the literature and input from our own expert faculty, we are proud to offer a comprehensive program with topics that include: prevention of preterm birth; update on Infertility and oncofertility; new advances in urogynecology; minimally invasive gynecologic surgery; updates in gynecology oncology. Lectures by USC faculty from the Keck School of Medicine of USC will outline controversies, discuss recent developments, and suggest recommendations. Participants will have direct access to the speakers and ample opportunity for intensive questions and answer post-lecture discussions.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

- Identify controversies and treatments of high-risk pregnancies.
- Implement strategies for cancer patients requesting fertility preservation.
- Discuss new advances in minimally invasive gynecologic surgery.

TARGET AUDIENCE

This course is intended for local and regional community Ob/Gyn physicians, Certified Nurse Midwives, Nurse Practitioners and other health care professionals who seek to enhance their understanding of current issues in women's health. The geographical target emphasizes local and regional community practices within the referral range to Keck Medical Center including Los Angeles County, Orange County and neighboring states.
